Crandall, 2003-09-12 How is it that cultures come into existence at all How do cultures develop particular customs and characteristics rather than others How do cultures persist and change over time Most previous attempts to address these questions have been descriptive and historical The purpose of this book is to provide answers that are explanatory predictive and relevant to the emergence and continuing evolution of cultures past present and future Most other investigations into cultural psychology have focused on the impact that culture has on the psychology of the individual The focus of this book is the reverse The authors show how questions about the origins and evolution of culture can be fruitfully answered through rigorous and creative examination of fundamental characteristics of human cognition motivation and social interaction They review recent theory and research that in many different ways points to the influence of basic psychological processes on the collective structures that define cultures These processes operate in all sorts of different populations ranging from very small interacting groups to grand scale masses of people occupying the same demographic or geographic category The cultural effects often unintended of individuals thoughts and actions are demonstrated in a wide variety of customs ritualized practices and shared mythologies for example religious beliefs moral standards rules for the allocation of resources norms for the acceptable expression of aggression gender stereotypes and scientific values The Psychological Foundations of Culture reveals that the consequences of psychological processes resonate well beyond the disciplinary constraints of psychology By taking a psychological approach to questions usually addressed by anthropologists sociologists and other social scientists it suggests that psychological research into the foundations of culture is a useful perhaps even necessary complement to other forms of inquiry

The Cognitive Foundations of Personality Traits

Shulamith Kreitler, Hans Kreitler, 2013-06-29 Hardly anything in psychology is as irking as the trait concept Psychologists and laypersons alike use primarily adjective trait names to characterize and even conceptualize the individuals they encounter There are more than a hundred well defined personality traits and a great many questionnaires for their assessment some of which are designed to assess the same or very similar traits Little is known about their ontogenetic development and even less about their underlying dynamics Psychoanalytic theory was invoked for explaining the psychodynamics underlying a few personality traits without however presenting sufficient empirical evidence for the validity of these interpretations In a reductionistic vein behaviorally inclined psychologists have propounded the thesis that all traits are acquired behaviors Yet

Representations of Child Sexual Abuse in Jamaica Tatyana Karpenko-Seccombe, Kenisha Nelson, Christine Fray, Roxanne Harvey, Karyl Powell-Booth, Adele Jones, Nadia Wager, Xiaomin Sheng, 2022-08-18 News media shape public opinion on social issues such as child sexual abuse CSA using particular language to foreground marginalize or legitimize certain viewpoints Given the prevalence of CSA and the impact of violence against children in Jamaica there is a need to examine the representation of children and their experience of violence in the news media which remain the main source of information about such abuse for much of the population The study aims to analyze accounts of CSA in Jamaican newspapers in order to show how different representations impact public understanding of CSA This study offers a new perspective around child abuse by using an eight million word corpus from articles over a three year period 2018 2020 The study argues that media reports often fail to conceptualise and represent accurately children who have experienced abuse Representations of children are generic their experiences often reduced to statistical summaries Corpus analysis uncovered the use of terms which normalize sexual abuse From the reader s perspective there was little emotional connection to the child or the child s experience The newspapers rarely report first hand survivors experience of abuse depriving these children of a voice Instead a marked preference is given to institutional voices An issue of concern is a tendency to sensationalism with disproportionate attention given to cases involving celebrities By exposing these problems the authors hope that news media in Jamaica can play a more positive role in heightening awareness around child abuse and allowing the voices of victims survivors to be heard
