was an English poet and playwright widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's pre eminent dramatist He is often called England's national poet and the Bard of Avon His extant works including some collaborations consist of about 38 plays 154 sonnets two long narrative poems and a few other verses the authorship of some of which is uncertain Sir Sidney Lee 1859-1926 was an English biographer and critic He was a lifelong scholar and enthusiast of Shakespeare His article on Shakespeare in the fifty first volume of the Dictionary of National Biography formed the basis of his Life of William Shakespeare This full length life is often credited as the first modern biography of the poet

Shakespeare, Paavo Cajanderin, 2014-09-23 Kuningas Lear on William Shakespearen tunnetuimpia tragedioita. Se on kirjoitettu luultavasti vuonna 1605 ja perustuu vanhaan brittiliseen kuningas Leirin taruun. Tarina oli yleisesti tunnettu Shakespearen aikoihin kuten monet muutkin tarinat joihin hänen näytelmänsä perustuvat. Miljöönsä on epähistoriallinen muinainen Britannia todellisuudessa Shakespearen oma aika kuten hänen muissakin näytelmissä. Toisin kuin Leirin kansantarina, kuningas Learissa on onneton loppu. Näytelmän pidetty muutenkin pessimistisen ja jopa nihilistisen mielen vuoksi, se on ollut epäsuosiossa ja sitä on toisinaan esitetty positiivisemmiksi muokattuina versioina. Toisen maailmansodan jälkeen Learia on kuitenkin pidetty yleisesti Shakespearen suurimpiin teoksiin kuuluvana. Näytelmän tunnetuimpiin kuuluu kohtaus, jossa Lear raivoaa myrskyssä. Kuningas Learilla on kolme tytärtä, joista kaksi vanhempaa on jo naimisissa. Nuorin Cordelia on isän suosikki ja monien kosima. Lear ilmoittaa päätöksensä luopua kruunusta ja jakaa valtakuntansa tyttärensä kesken. Hän yrittää saada lapsensa kilpailemaan keskenään rakkaudesta isänsä Reganin ja Gonerilin vakuuttavien rakkauttaan vuolaasti kun taas Cordelia kieltäytyy ylisanoista. Lear raivostuu hylkittyä Cordeliasta. Ranskan kuninkaan vaimoksi ja jakaa koko omaisuutensa Reganille ja Gonerilille. Kentin jaarli yrittää varoittaa päätöksestä, jolloin Lear ajaa hänet maanpakoon. Lear pyrkii vierailemaan Reganin ja Gonerilin luona uskoen saavansa kunnioitusta, mutta nämä suhtautuvat häneen tylysti ja yrittävät saada hänet luopumaan jäljellä olevasta ritarisaattueestaan, jota pitävät uhkana. Matti Rossin suomennoksessa Tammi 1975 Goneril sanoo Satahäntä ratsumiestä Heiktimme kapakaksi tai bordelliksi tekevät Lear ymmärtäen, että tytöt eivät pidä häntä vaan pitävät häntä vain vanhana hälmäyksenä. Leirin maailmankuvan perusta murtuu ja hänen tulee hulluksi. Maanpakoon ajettu Kentin jaarli on yhä uskollinen Learille ja lyttää häntä palvelijakseen valepuvussa Learia seuraavaksi. Hän ei näytä pilkkaavaa eikä lohduttavaa, mutta Gloucesterin jaarlin poika Edmund on katkera, koska hänelle ei kuulu mitään Gloucesterin perinnestä vaan kaiken perii laillinen poika Edgar. Hän uskottelee isälleen Edgarin suunnittelevan tämän murhaa Gloucester menee raivosta suunniltaan ja Edgar joutuu pakenemaan hulluksi kerjäliseksi naamioituneena Reganin ja Gonerilin huhutaan olevan riidoissa ja Ranskan kuningas tekee maihinnousun hajanaiseen maahan Edmund uskottelee Reganin miehelle Cornwallille isänsä Gloucesterin olevan ranskalaisten kanssa liittoutunut petturi, jolloin Cornwall lupaa rangaista Gloucesteria ja antaa Edmundille Gloucesterin jaarlin aseman. Regan ja Cornwall vangitsevat Gloucesterin puhkaisevat hänen silmänsä ja lähetävät hänet harhailemaan sokeana. Hirmutytöt kauhistunut palvelija surmaa Cornwallin Gloucester jolle Edmundin petos on nyt selvinnyt, tämä poikaansa Edgariin joka kerjäläisen esiintynä lupaa viedä hänet Doveriin Gloucester haluaa tehdä itsemurhan hyppäällä Doverin jyrkanteeltä, mutta Edgarin juoni estää sen. Goneril halveksii miehen Albany, joka moittii häntä moraalityöksi ja tavoittelee mieheksi Edmundia, kuten myös leskeksi jättänyt Regan. Hän lähetää palvelijansa Oswaldin viemään Edmundille kirjeen Oswaldin matkalla Edgariin ja Gloucesteriin. Edgar surmaa Oswaldin ja saa kiinsä kirjeen, jossa Goneril pyytää Edmundia murhaamaan miehen. Lear pöytää ranskalaisten leiriin, jossa Cordelia kokee läkensä parantaa häntä hulluudesta. Albany, Edmund, Regan ja Goneril ovat varustaneet sotajoukon ranskalaisia vastaan Edmundin johtama joukko voittaa ranskalaiset ja Cordelia sekä jatkaisiin saanut Lear vangitaan.
