ABG (Arterial Blood Gas)

Analyses arterial blood for oxygen, carbon dioxide and bicarbonate content in addition to blood PH

* used to determine the effectiveness of respiration

Aseptic

The absence of microorganisms or by contrast, something that just discourages the growth of microorganisms is antiseptic

Basilic Vein

The large vein on the inner side of the bicep and is often chosen for intravenous injections and blood drawing

Battery

The basis of tort in this case the unprivileged touching of one person by another.

Informed Consent

Patient gives consent for a procedure to be performed in full knowledge of the procedure and the risk it entails

Bleeding Time

A test done to ascertain platelet function.

A Plug is

A special paper applied to a wound (small incision) in the forearm. The paper is applied and then timed to see how long it takes for platelets to form a "plug" and stop the bleeding

Aspirin will affect

bleeding time results

Blood Clot

The conversion of blood from a liquid form to solid through the process of coagulation

Thrombus is

a clot which forms inside of a blood vessel

An embolism is

a clot that moves inside the vessel it is referred to as an embolus

Blood borne infection

an infection transmitted from blood to blood
