It presents empirical insights into how a multidisciplinary team of researchers, teacher educators, and policy personnel mobilized for collective change in a standards-driven reform initiative. It gives an account of a bold move to install a collaborative culture of evidence-informed inquiry to professionalize teacher education. The discussion of competence assessment standards and change processes presented in the book has relevance beyond teacher education to other professions.
