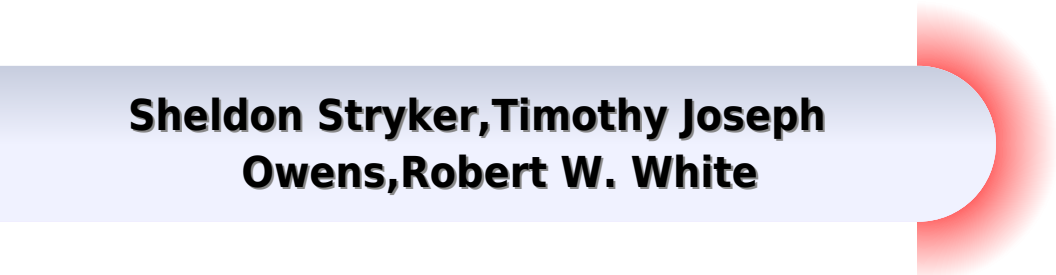


Abstract

Experts in the field of fashion and psychology have contended that clothing gives information about the wearer's identity, while also delineating and communicating social identity of the wearer to the surrounding observers. Clothing (along with other personal accessories) categorizes the wearer as belonging to a certain social and economic class (rich/poor; urban/rural dweller; chairperson/factory worker), of a specific gender (like a male or a female member of the society), age (children, young adults, adults, or old people), and profession (like doctor, lawyer or a priest). Therefore, one can conclude that clothing is a mode of communication (nonverbal), which creates the first and a lasting impression of the wearer, on the observer. It is almost impossible to wear clothes without revealing to some extent the personal and social identity of the wearer, and his or her view of the world. The present study explores all existing links between clothing and personal identity, and derives that a close relationship exists between the two at different levels, while taking into consideration the wearer's gender, age, social class, religion, ethnicity and symbolism of clothing.
