three main causes for the genocide ethnic identity ideology and mass media indoctrination in particular the influence of hate radio Straus's research does not deny the importance of ethnicity but he finds that it operated more as a background condition Instead Straus emphasizes fear and intra ethnic intimidation as the primary drivers of the violence A defensive civil war and the assassination of a president created a feeling of acute insecurity Rwanda's unusually effective state was also central as was the country's geography and population density which limited the number of exit options for both victims and perpetrators In conclusion Straus steps back from the particulars of the Rwandan genocide to offer a new dynamic model for understanding other instances of genocide in recent history the Holocaust Armenia Cambodia the Balkans and assessing the future likelihood of such events
