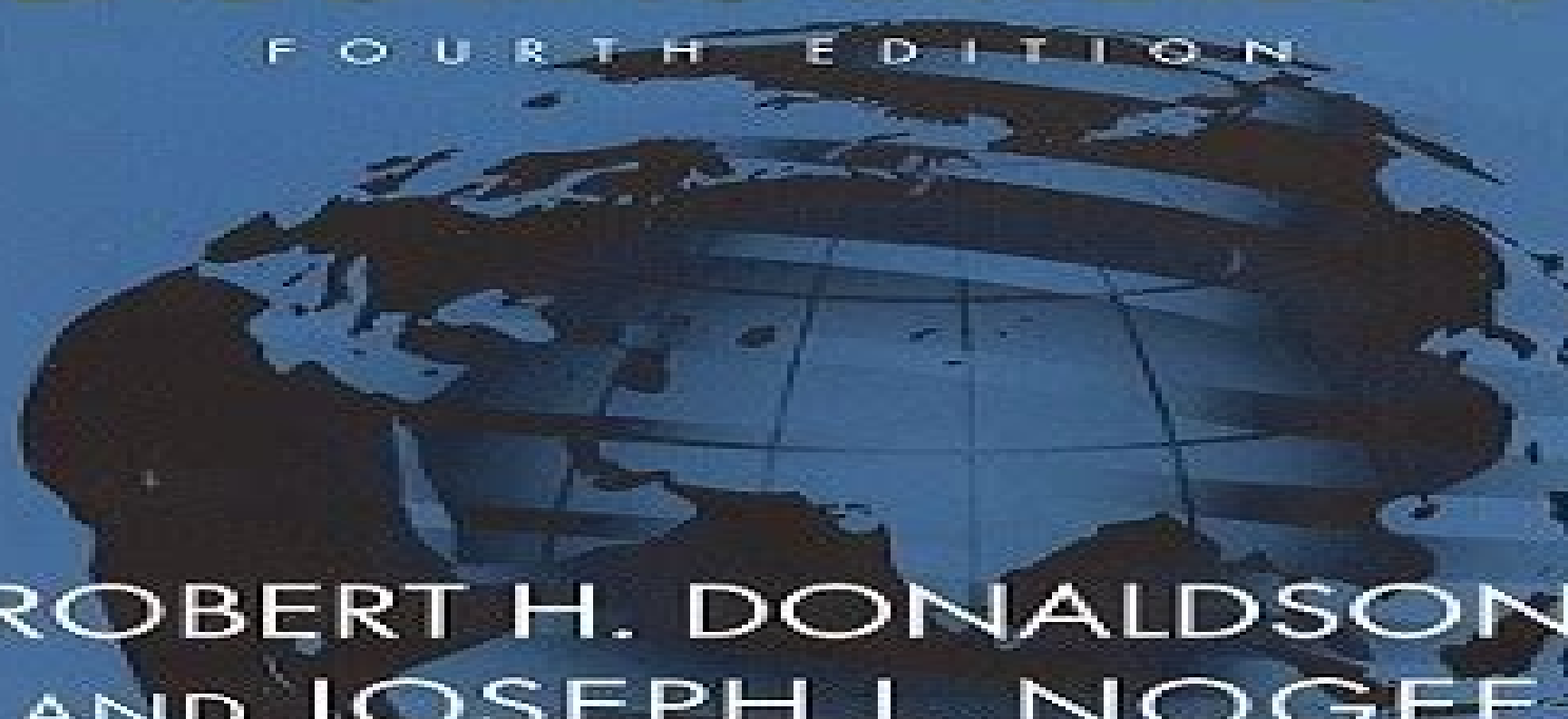

tensions remained and there were still restrictions on contacts the Soviet overtures can best be described as a half offered hand of friendship and perhaps it was less of a thaw than the end of a blizzard Nevertheless these contacts began a process which would help end the Cold War three decades later This history of relations between the Soviet Union and the United States during the Eisenhower and Khrushchev administrations explores political social and cultural exchanges and assesses their impact upon the two countries Besides diplomatic documents memoirs from Americans and Soviets and works of history it relies upon eyewitness accounts by journalists tourists and others to paint a detailed picture of the era Notes are included for each chapter and there is a bibliography and an index
