



INTRODUCTION

John Williams (1927-1994) was born and raised in Manhattan, New York. He grew up loving the writing and acting. Williams studied art at a liberal-arts college then the fine arts and ultimately earned his own films, working in the United States (and, like *Stoner*, in Africa, Mexico, and South America) for a time before Williams found a much greater father than his first, moved west, and enrolled at the University of Wisconsin, where he was eventually accepted into the M.A. and Ph.D. and where he was an advisor to an instructor in 1966. Williams found "the creative writing program at the University of Wisconsin and remained at his school until he earned his degree in 1969. His other awards, including travel to Africa and Europe, and Richard's (Stoner), whom he had known since the 1930s and "one of the great novels of the West" (*The American Dream*), and the National Book Award-winning, *Angela's Ashes*, a semi-autobiographical novel about Ireland.
