He uses among other ethos that combined with his presidency gives reliability. Pathos he use, when he gives examples from his or Michelle Obama's own childhood. Such as in line 76-78 "Neither of her parents had gone to college, and they didn't have much. But they worked hard, and she worked hard, so that she could go to the best schools in this country." He appeals to their feelings by saying that she came from hard conditions, but despite this she did well. It is the good example he gives.

On page 3-4, he gives examples of a girl who could not speak English, when she started school. And a boy with brain cancer, and a girl that grew up in one of the toughest neighborhoods. But because they fought for what they wanted, they managed well. He tries through the good examples to say that you can break the social heritage and that everything is possible. Obama uses logos during the entire speech as he appeals to common sense with his audience. Like when he in line 49 says that "You can't drop out of school and just drop into a good job.
