They defend actionable plans, usually answer the guestion "how". In the first stanza of Manuel L. Ouezon speech he said that " National strength can only be built on character" and that is an example of claim of fact, because we will have a progressive nation if we have a good character. Because good character is equivalent to a good country. Also, in the first stanza of his speech, you can find an example of claim of policy, " We must find the flaws, if there be any, in our concept of individual and community life, as well as in our character, and proceed at once to remedy them "I can say that this is an example of claim of policy because from the word "must" and it answered the question "
