According to the early 17th century Doctor, Tobias Venner and his enlightened, liberalistic philosophical paradigm; obesity is: "An individual disease process, of a fat an gross habit of body, which is far worse than a lean individual body, as it is more prone to become sick." pp.19-20. (Gilman, 1998, pp.19-20) (Blackburn, 2005, pp. 209-210). However from a social constructivist, philosophical paradigm perspective, obesity is seen as a socially constructed illness, which is something quite different entirely (Blackburn, 2005, pp.158, 342). Indeed according to the Political Scientist Oliver, a social constructivist, philosophical paradigm, tends to envisage health concerns, such as obesity within a social context, so as to fully understand and identify the health issue concerned (Oliver, 2006, pp. 611-626) (Haralamobos, Holborn, 1991, pp. 2-5, 19, 758-761, 768, 799-804).
