Violence in Post-Conflict Societies Anders Themnér, 2011-05-10 This book compares post civil war societies to look at the presence or absence of organized violence analysing why some ex combatants return to organised violence and others do not Even though former fighters have been identified as a major source of insecurity there have been few efforts to systematically examine why some ex combatants re engage in organized violence while others do not This book compares the presence or absence of organized violence in different ex combatant communities former fighters that used to belong to the same armed faction and who share a common horizontal identity based on shared war and peacetime experiences in the Republic of Congo ex Cobras Cocoyes and Ninjas and Sierra Leone ex Armed Forces Revolutionary Council Civil Defense Force and Revolutionary United Front The main determinants of ex combatant violence are whether former fighters have access to elites and to second tier individuals such as former mid level commanders who can act as intermediaries between the two By utilizing relationships based on selective incentives and social networks these two kinds of remobilizers are able to generate the needed enticements and feelings of affinity trust or fear to convince ex combatants to resort to arms These findings demonstrate that the outbreak of ex combatant violence can only be understood by more clearly incorporating an actor perspective focusing on three levels of analysis the elite midlevel and grass root This book will be of much interest to students of peacebuilding civil wars post conflict reconstruction war and conflict studies security studies and IR

Post-Conflict Tajikistan John Heathershaw, 2009-05-07 Post Soviet post conflict Tajikistan is an under studied and poorly understood case in conflict studies literature Since 2000 this Central Asian state has seen major political violence end countrywide order emerge and the peace agreement between the parties of the 1990s civil war hold Superficially Tajikistan appears to be a case of successful international intervention for liberal peacebuilding yet the Tajik peace is characterised by authoritarian governance Via discourse analysis and extensive fieldwork including participant observation with international organizations the author examines how peacebuilding is understood and practised The book challenges received wisdom that peacebuilding is a process of democratisation or institutionalisation showing how interventions have inadvertently served to facilitate an increasingly authoritarian peace and fostered popular accommodation and avoidance strategies Chapters investigate assistance to political parties and elections the security sector and community development and illustrate how transformative aims are thwarted whilst success is simulated for an audience of international donors At the same time the book charts the emergence of a legitimate order with properties of authority sovereignty and livelihoods Providing a challenge to the theoretical literature on peacebuilding and concentrating on an under studied Central Asian state this book will be of interest to academics working on Peace Studies International Relations and Central Asian Studies

Liberal Peacebuilding and Global Governance David Roberts, 2011-03 This book examines the limits to cosmopolitan liberal peacebuilding caused by its preoccupation with the values and assumptions of neoliberal global governance The peace people experience is determined by the processes privileged in peacebuilding This book is about four things that shape the processes involved First it is a critique of orthodox postconflict peacebuilding It takes the position that the present approach although seemingly hegemonic is routinely ignored or manipulated by elites and society and converted into a miasma that to some degree wastes the energies and opportunities involved Second it is about alternatives which invoke the kind of peace people might seek in postconflict places if they had more control over the process of peacebuilding a notion referred to here as popular peace It is thus not the kind of critical work that some describe as reflexive anti liberalism Rather it seeks alternatives that are grounded in the lives of people in postconflict spaces and which also reflect some of the essential values of Liberalism Third it is about the role of both informal and formal actors institutions and practices in the creation of such a peace For instance it is concerned with the legitimacy of informal practices that lie beyond Liberal tolerance and which are vital in the pursuit of everyday peace Fourth it is about a transversal rather than vertical or hierarchical relationship of global and local governance in securing a peace that reflects the needs and values of both In short this work is a response to

the substantial inconsistencies that appear between peacebuilding rhetoric and everyday outcomes in postconflict places This book will be of much interest to students of peacebuilding post conflict statebuilding conflict studies global governance and International Relations in general **The Evolution of Military Power in the West and Asia** Pauline Eadie,Wyn
