## metonymy

A figure of speech where one word is replaced with a word that's closely associated with it. For example, you might hear Washington used to refer to the U.S. government.

# hyperbole

When a writer exaggerates something typically in a humorous

## simile

A direct comparison between two things, using like OF RES



Jamie runs as fast as the wind.

## cliche

A phrase that is repeated so often, it's mearly meaningless.



Try walking a mile in my shoes.

# onomatopoeia

The name of an action imitates the sound it makes.



The bees buzz amgrily when their hive is disturbed.

# metaphor

A comparison between two things. They don't necessarily have to be allike, but they should make a link in the reader's mind.

Nobody invites Edward to parties because he is a wet blambot.

# symbolism

When something that has one meaning is used to represent something entirely different. For example, using an image of the American flag to represent patriotism.

The boy proudly flew his flag on the 4th of July

## idiom

An expression used by a group of people with a meaning that can only be understood. through common usage. (Many idioms are also considered cliches.)

I'm waiting for him to kick the bucket.

## synecdoche

a figure of speech using a word or words to represent a whole. For example, when | = you refer to credit cards as "meastic"...

Rather than using cash, she just paid with her plastic.
