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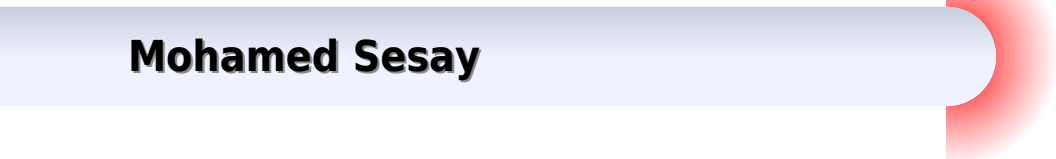

Domination Through Law Mohamed Sesay,2021-01-29 Winner of the 2021 Lee Ann Fujii Book Award International Studies Association The positive effects of rule of law norms and institutions are often assumed in the fields of global governance and international development with empirical work focusing more on the challenges of using law to engineer social change abroad Questioning this assumption the book contends that purportedly good rule of law standards do not always deliver benign benefits but rather often have negative consequences that harm the very local constituents which rule of law promoters promise to help In particular the book argues that rule of law promotion in post colonial societies reinforces socioeconomic and political inequality which disproportionately favors dominant actors who have the wealth education and influence to navigate the state legal system In addition to an historical account of legal development in settler colonial environments this argument is also drawn from a comparative study which focuses on the UK supported justice sector development programs in Sierra Leone and the US funded rule of law projects in Liberia

A Study of Service Tax in India and it's Analysis Dr. Makarand Raghunath Sakhalkar,2018-03-05 Based on recommendations made by Chelliah Committee on Tax Reforms Service Tax was introduced for the first time in the year 1994 It is a Union levy with a selective approach whereby it is applicable to selected categories of services and not to all the services The system of levy and collection of Excise Duties on goods is in existence since 1944 under Central Excise Act 1944 However the concept of levy and collection of Service Tax on paid services was introduced in India for the first time in 1994 by the then Finance Minister Dr Manmohan Singh It is a tax levied on the transaction of certain specified services by the

Central Government under the Finance Act 1994 It is an indirect tax which means that normally the service provider pays the tax and recovers the amount from the recipient of taxable service

Financial Structures in Sierra Leone Emmanuel S. E. Leigh, Sierra Leone exhibits the typical features of a developing country in the African economy with high ratio of foreign trade to gross domestic product GDP low level of urbanization and high level of monetization The financial structure is narrow with the central bank being the forefront of regulation the commercial banks and other financial institutions being the key players After independence the government pursued wide range of planning and development strategies with industrialization at the helm With a shift in focus to implement rapid rate of economic development monetary and financial institutions were designed to assume the responsibility of mobilizing domestic resources as capital for development Therefore the West African Currency Board WACB was found inappropriate in the changed environment and was thus replaced by the Bank of Sierra Leone The Bank of Sierra Leone Central Bank was established to serve as an agency that would build up reputable standards of financial management and integrity In this instant the Bank formulated and implemented monetary and supervisory policies to foster sound financial environment The Bank therefore continues to pursue tight monetary policy position consistent with positive economic growth The Government has highlighted the importance of the financial sector to realize that long term goal for 2035 and has designed a Financial Sector Development Plan as a framework for creating a sound and well functioning financial system to support the Government's overall growth objectives and poverty reduction strategies The book was written in perspective to capture the attention of scholars and financial authorities in the country Facts have been documented and perceptions taken from real life experiences in some of the institutions mentioned in the text For those scholars and researchers aiming to gain knowledge of financial structures in Sierra Leone the book can lead them to major topics which should stimulate further studies
