European Thought and Culture, 1350-1992 Michael J. Sauter, 2021-06-06 This book explores the main currents of European thought between 1350 and 1992 which it approaches in two principal ways culture as produced by place and the progressive unmooring of thought from previously set religious and philosophical boundaries The book reads the period against spatial thought s history spatial sciences such as geography or Euclidean geometry to argue that Europe cannot be understood as a continent in intellectual terms or its history organized with respect to traditional spatial geographic categories Instead we need to understand European intellectual history in terms of a culture that defined its own place as opposed to a place that produced a given culture It then builds on this idea to argue that Europe s overweening drive to know more about humanity and the cosmos continually breached the boundaries set by venerable religious and philosophical traditions In this respect spatial thought foregrounded the human at the unchanging s expense with European thought slowly becoming unmoored as it doggedly produced knowledge at wisdom s expense Michael J Sauter illustrates this by pursuing historical themes across different chapters including European thought s exit from the medieval period the Renaissance the Reformation the Scientific Revolution the Enlightenment and Romanticism the Industrial Revolution and war and culture offering a thorough overview of European thought during this period The book concludes by explaining how contemporary culture has forgotten what early modern thinkers such as Michel de Montaigne still knew namely that too little skepticism toward one s own certainties makes one a danger to others Offering a comprehensive introduction to European thought that stretches from the late fourteenth to the late twentieth century this is the perfect one volume study for students of European intellectual history

The Politics of Culture in Quattrocento Europe Oren Margolis, 2016-05-06 The poet king without a throne appears here in an entirely new light In *The Politics of Culture in Quattrocento Europe* Ren of Anjou in Italy Oren Margolis explores how this French prince and exiled king of Naples 1409 1480 engaged his Italian network in a programme of cultural politics conducted with an eye towards a return to power in the peninsula Built on a series of original interpretations of humanistic and artistic material chiefly Latin orations and illuminated manuscripts of classical texts this is also a case study for a diplomatic approach to culture It recasts its source base as a form of high level communication for a hyper literate elite of those who could read the works created by humanist and artistic agents for their constituent parts the potent words or phrases and relevant classical allusions the channels through which a given work was commissioned or transmitted and then the nature of the network gathered around a political agenda This is a volume for all those interested in the politics and culture of later medieval Europe and Renaissance Italy the kings of France and dukes of Burgundy the Medici the Sforza the Venetians and their armies ambassadors and adversaries all appear here so do Giovanni Bellini Andrea Mantegna Guarino of Verona and their respective intellectual and artistic circles Emerging from it is a challenge to conventional interpretations of the politics of humanism and a new vision of the Quattrocento a century in which the Italian Renaissance began its takeover of Europe but in which Renaissance culture was itself shaped by its European political social and diplomatic context

Machiavelli's Ethics Erica Benner, 2009-10-26 *Machiavelli's Ethics* challenges the most entrenched understandings of Machiavelli arguing that he was a moral and political philosopher who consistently favored the rule of law over that of men that he had a coherent theory of justice and that he did not defend the Machiavellian maxim that the ends justify the means By carefully reconstructing the principled foundations of

his political theory Erica Benner gives the most complete account yet of Machiavelli's thought. She argues that his difficult and puzzling style of writing owes far more to ancient Greek sources than is usually recognized as does his chief aim to teach readers not how to produce deceptive political appearances and rhetoric but how to see through them. Drawing on a close reading of Greek authors including Thucydides, Xenophon, Plato, and Plutarch, Benner identifies a powerful and neglected key to understanding Machiavelli. This important new interpretation is based on the most comprehensive study of Machiavelli's writings to date, including a detailed examination of all of his major works: *The Prince*, *The Discourses*, *The Art of War*, and *Florentine Histories*. It helps explain why readers such as Bacon and Rousseau could see Machiavelli as a fellow moral philosopher and how they could view *The Prince* as an ethical and republican text. By identifying a rigorous structure of principles behind Machiavelli's historical examples, the book should also open up fresh debates about his relationship to later philosophers including Rousseau, Hobbes, and Kant.

Selected Writings of an Eighteenth-Century Venetian Woman of Letters Elisabetta Caminer Turra, 2007-11-01
Elisabetta Caminer Turra (1751-1906) was one of the most prominent women in eighteenth-century Italy and a central figure in the international Republic of Letters. A journalist and publisher, Caminer participated in important debates on capital punishment, freedom of the press, and the abuse of clerical power. She also helped spread Enlightenment ideas into Italy by promoting and publishing Voltaire's latest works and translating new European plays. Plays she herself directed to great applause on Venetian stages. Bringing together Caminer's letters, poems, and journalistic writings, nearly all published for the first time here, *Selected Writings* offers readers an intellectual biography of this remarkable figure as well as a glimpse into her intimate correspondence with the most prominent thinkers of her day. But more important, *Selected Writings* provides insight into the passion that animated Caminer's fervent reflections on the complex and shifting condition of women in her society, the same passion that pushed her to succeed in the male-dominated literary professions.

Boccaccio's Florence Elsa Filosa, 2022-11-01
Best known as the author of the *Decameron*, Giovanni Boccaccio is a key figure in Italian literature. In the mid-fourteenth century, however, Boccaccio was also deeply involved in the politics of Florence, and the extent of his involvement steered and inspired his work as a writer. *Boccaccio's Florence* explores the financial, political, and social turbulence of Florence at this time, as well as the major players in literary and political circles, to understand the complex ways they emerged in Boccaccio's writing.
