Reducing Fuel Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions of Medium- and Heavy-Duty Vehicles, Phase Two National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Transportation Research Board, Division on Engineering and Physical Sciences, Board on Energy and Environmental Systems, Committee on Assessment of Technologies and Approaches for Reducing the Fuel Consumption of Medium- and Heavy-Duty Vehicles, Phase Two, 2020-05-15 Medium and heavy duty trucks motor coaches and transit buses collectively medium and heavy duty vehicles or MHDVs are used in every sector of the economy The fuel consumption and greenhouse gas emissions of MHDVs have become a focus of legislative and regulatory action in the past few years This study is a follow on to the National Research Council's 2010 report Technologies and Approaches to Reducing the Fuel Consumption of Medium and Heavy Duty Vehicles That report provided a series of findings and recommendations on the development of regulations for reducing fuel consumption of MHDVs On September 15 2011 NHTSA and EPA finalized joint Phase I rules to establish a comprehensive Heavy Duty National Program to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and fuel consumption for on road medium and heavy duty vehicles As NHTSA and EPA began working on a second round of standards the National Academies issued another report Reducing the Fuel Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions of Medium and Heavy Duty Vehicles Phase Two First Report providing recommendations for the Phase II standards This third and final report focuses on a possible third phase of regulations to be promulgated by these agencies in the next decade
