Pacific and Auden's Funeral Blues As before the text emphasizes work of the past century poems from 1900 or later take up more than half of the anthology's pages In its first edition The Broadview Anthology of Poetry included biographical information about the poets at the back of the anthology for the new edition biographical material appears in a headnote to each poet Two other features are also new to this edition the date of first publication is appended after each poem and line numbering is used throughout The numbers have been kept unobtrusive however as with the first edition the designers have endeavored to give a clean look to the pages of the anthology A substantial section on prosody figures of speech and so on is included as an appendix
