## Bill Nye Buoyancy Season 1 Episode 4

**Objective:** To understand the concept of buoyancy and how it affects the behavior of objects in fluids.

**Materials:** A container of water, a small object (e.g., a rock), a large object (e.g., a block of wood).

1. The object that floats in water is called a buoyant object.
2. The buoyant force is the upward force exerted by a fluid that opposes the weight of an object immersed in it.
3. The buoyant force is equal to the weight of the fluid displaced by the object.
4. The weight of the object is equal to the weight of the fluid displaced by the object.
5. The weight of the object is equal to the weight of the fluid displaced by the object.

**Procedure:** Follow the steps below to perform the experiment.

| Object  | Weight (N) | Volume (m <sup>3</sup> ) | Density (kg/m <sup>3</sup> ) |
|---------|------------|--------------------------|------------------------------|
| 1. Rock | 1.0        | 0.001                    | 1000                         |
| 2. Wood | 0.5        | 0.002                    | 250                          |
