Introduction

Vitamin B12 is vital as it comprises an important element in DNA synthesis and individual neurological functioning. This necessitates continuous intake of the vitamin to enhance the prevention of possible hematologic and neuropsychiatric disorders upon lack of continued intake of the vitamin.
