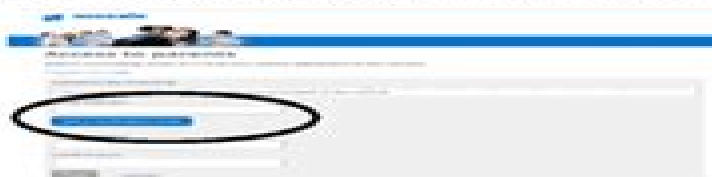
Go to www.parentportal.ca
Click on the Log in button.



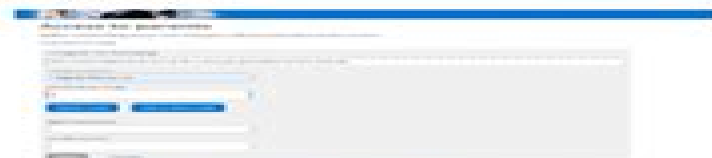
Click on the Create your account link.

Click on **Click here to fill in the form**.



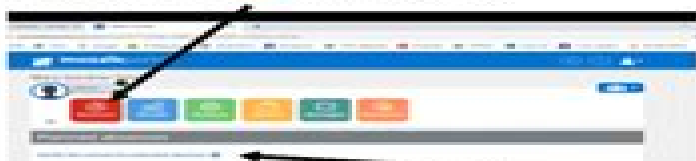
Fill in the information needed.
