

"Poor living conditions were the greatest challenge faced by migrants in Britain in the period 1700-present." How far do you agree? Explain your answer (15 marks)

I disagree with the statement that poor living conditions were the greatest challenge faced by migrants in Britain in the period 1700-present, since they also faced prejudice and job-exploitation, which were more challenging.

Prejudice was arguably the greatest challenge faced by migrants as it made it hard for them to fit into British society, affecting their well-being and sense of belonging. One example of this would be the Jews. Although many anti-semitic laws were lifted at that period, they still faced anti-semitic hostility and attacks due to their cultural differences. Jews were seen as different, especially as most of them spoke Yiddish, which created a language barrier between them and the non-Jewish population. Their difference in religion and clothing made them seen as outsiders. As a result, they were used as scapegoats for the Jack the Ripper murders in the East End of London, suggesting that they struggled to win the acceptance of the English. In addition, Irish migrants also faced racism due to their difference in religion and political views. In cartoons, newspaper articles, speeches by politicians and popular jokes, Irish people were portrayed as savage, violent, drunken and animal-like. Anti-Irish racism was widespread and nasty. There were sometimes anti-Irish and anti-Catholic riots and sometimes violence between Irish Catholics and Protestants, for example in the 1840s and 1850s in Cardiff, Greenock, Stockport and towns in north-west England. This created a huge divide between the Irish and the English, making their hard life even worse. Therefore, prejudice was the greatest challenge faced by the migrants, making it difficult for them to settle in this hostile environment.

Job exploitation and the poor working conditions were also a significant challenge faced by the migrants, as they worked for long hours only for low wages. In Whitechapel, many Jewish migrants had to work in illegal sweatshops despite efforts from trade unions to make conditions better. Their low wages and the terrible working conditions led to resentment amongst the community, which was fuelled by the fact that police in the East of London could not shut the sweatshops down due to the lack of communication. The low wages and the lack of job opportunities also led to rising poverty and unemployment, which were further exacerbated by the arrival of thousands of Jews, making the situation tense. Similarly, many Irish migrants who worked as labourers in the docks had low wages. Many were so poor that they turned to begging, showing how job exploitation posed a significant challenge to migrants.

However, one could argue that poor living conditions posed the greatest challenge for migrants. Many Irish migrants lived in run-down back-to-back tenements, facing issues of overcrowding with as many as 60 people sharing a single toilet. Inadequate drainage and sewage systems were common, leading to the easy spread of diseases like cholera and typhus. Similarly, Jewish migrants in
