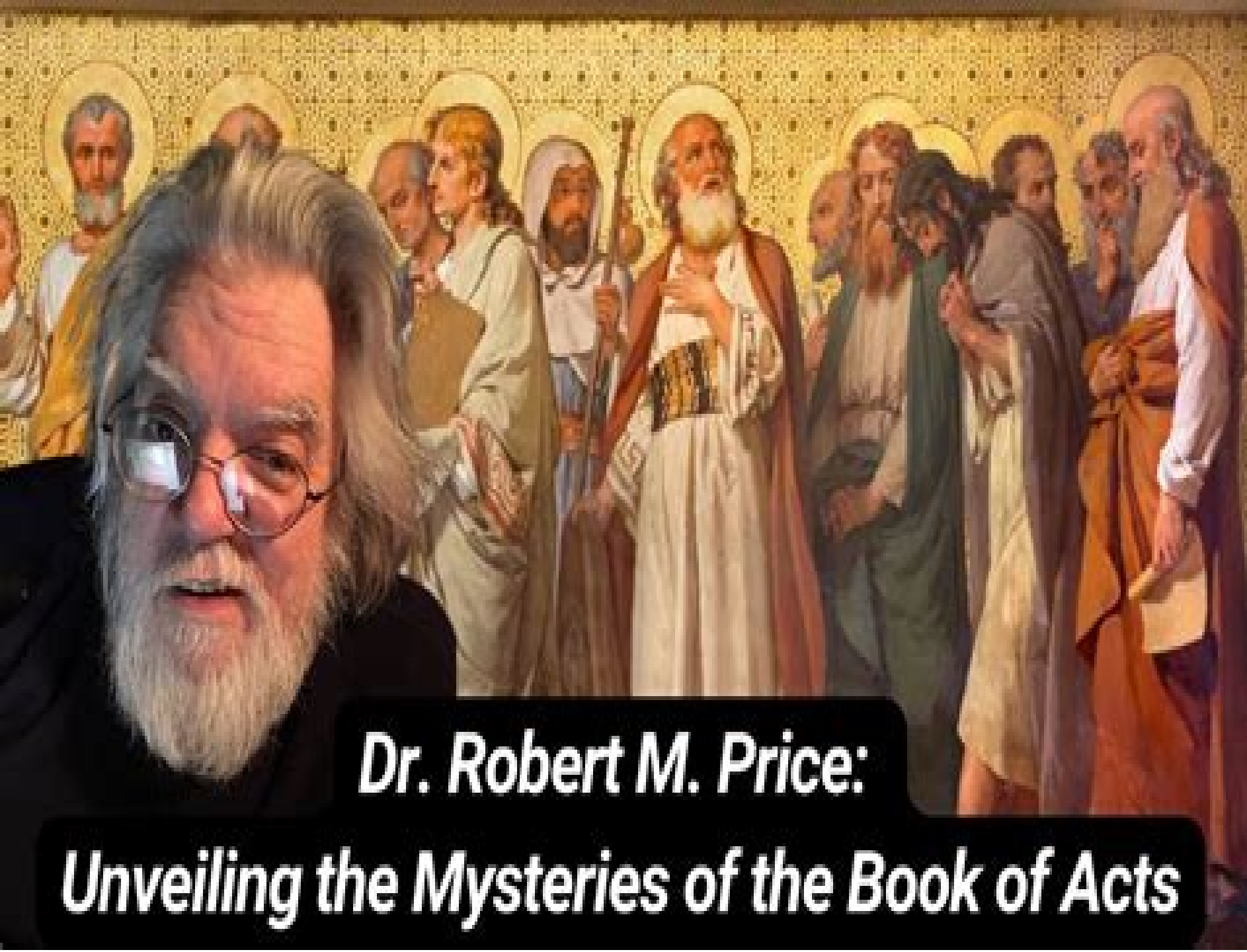

between the charismatic ascetics such as Marcion and Thecla as examples and the emerging Catholic orthodoxy of such clergy as Ignatius and Polycarp. The tension is detectable in the texts themselves, many of which represent heretical points of view. Gnostic, Jewish, Christian, Marcionite, and proto-orthodox and were later edited, sometimes clumsily, in an attempt to harmonize all into one consistent theology. What may occur to many readers among the more striking aspects of the narratives is that the earliest, most basic writings such as Mark's Gospel, in inarticulate Greek, are ultimately more impressive and inspirational than the later attempts by more educated Christians to appeal to sophisticated readers with better grammar and more allusions to classical mythology and apologetic embellishments. The critical insights and theories on display in these pages have seldom been incorporated into mainstream, conservative Bible translations, and in many ways Price has made the New Testament a whole new book for readers, allowing them, by virtue of the translation, to comprehend the meaning of the text where it is obscured by the traditional wording. Whatever usefulness teachers, students, and clergy may find here, in terms of pedagogical and inspirational value, the Pre-Nicene New Testament is guaranteed to provoke further thought and conversation among the general public, hopefully toward the goal of more personal study and insights.
