Ophthalmoscopy - The Examination of the inside of the eye.

Vertex distance - The distance from the back surface of the lens to the front of the eye.

Fundus - The interior portion of the eyeball that may be seen on ophthalmoscopy.

Sub-conjunctival hemorrhage - A broken blood vessel between the sclera and conjunctiva.

Conventional daily wear lenses - One type of contact lens is applied after waking and removed before going to sleep.

Macula - The part of the retina responsible for sharp, clear vision.
