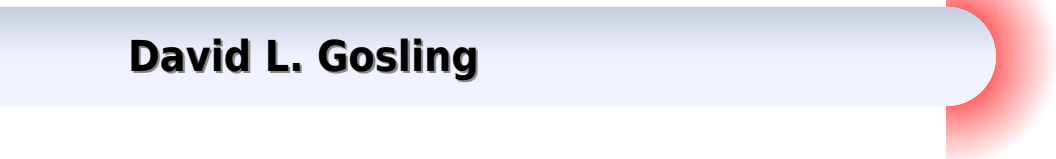

Andrew Kraebel, 2020-03-05 A new history of the origins of the English Bible revealing the complex continuities between Latin commentaries and English translations *Football's Past Revisited* Graham Curry, 2024-10-28 This book delves into the complex yet fascinating evolution of football From a relatively unruly mob game played on festival days the game was adopted codified and civilised by the major English Public Schools and then diffused into the wider society to become a codified modern sports form The birth of the Football Association in 1863 in London provided compromise rules enabling teams geographically divided by distance and football's differing interpretations to oppose each other which marked a pivotal moment for the sport Thereon history records the establishment of the FA Cup football's internationalisation the advent of professionalism and perhaps finally the establishment of a national league structure all of these developments originally taking place in the British Isles Within this multifaceted framework eminent sociologists and historians have attempted to wrestle with these processes As a result over the past two decades researchers and academics have reached the conclusion that although a solid grounding in the macro history of football is required testing the existing hypotheses and questions in the early development of the game is best explored by drilling down deeply into local studies using a micro historical

approach Consequently many of the chapters included in this book on Staffordshire Norfolk London Sheffield East Lancashire Rugby School follow this methodology This book is an essential read for students scholars and academics of sports studies history sociology development and management as well as an engrossing read for anyone interested in the early history of football The chapters in this book were originally published as a special issue of Soccer Society

The Coming Storm Nigel McCrery,2017-07-30 The outbreak of the Second World War came towards the closing stages of the 1939 cricket season Hitler permitted us almost to complete an exceptionally interesting season Sir Home Gordon wrote in the Cricketer magazine When shall we see the stumps pitched again As the West Indies touring team canceled their last five matches and sailed home before the U boat threat developed the treasures at Lords including the Ashes were sent to a secret location for safekeeping The Marylebone Cricket Club cancelled its tour to India England played under the MCC banner then During the ensuing conflict twelve test cricketers five English two South Africans one Australian and one New Zealander perished together with 130 first class players In this superbly researched sequel to Final Wicket covering cricketing fatalities during The Great War this book reveals each mans career details including cricketing statistics and the circumstances of death There is also a brief history of the game during the War Arguably the period between the two world wars was the golden age of cricket and this book honors those who made it so only to die serving their countries in a different way

Rowe,2023-04-15 The first biography of the philosopher who became a mastermind of Allied intelligence in World War Two Austere witty and formidable J L Austin 1911 1960 was the leader of Oxford Ordinary Language Philosophy and the founder of speech act theory This book the first full length biography of Austin enhances our understanding of his dominance in 1950s Oxford examining the significance of his famous Saturday morning seminars and his sometimes tense relationships with Gilbert Ryle Isaiah Berlin A J Ayer and Elizabeth Anscombe Throwing new light on Austin s own intellectual development it probes the strengths and weaknesses of his mature philosophy and reconstructs his late unpublished work on sound symbolism Austin s philosophical work remains highly influential but much less well known is his outstanding contribution to British Intelligence in World War Two The twelve central chapters thus investigate Austin s part in the North African campaign the search for the V weapons the preparations for D Day the Battle of Arnhem and the Ardennes Offensive and show that in the case of D Day he played a major role in the ultimate Allied victory While exploring Austin s dramatic and romantic personal history Rowe pays close attention to his harsh schooling and pre war affair with a married Frenchwoman his wartime marriage bomb injury and response to a colleague s murder and his post war family life the growing influence of America and his tragically premature death Adding considerably to our knowledge of World War Two and Austin s diverse and enduring influence this biography reveals the true complexity of his character and the full range and significance of his achievements Educating Against Extremism Lynn Davies,2008 Extremism is a huge concern across the world right now fuelled by its links to terrorism and religious fundamentalism This book explores the relationship of education to extremism and examines how education could counter its more dangerous forms Formal education does little to prevent people joining extremist groups Neither does it equip young people to analyze fundamentalism We have seen attacks by suicide bombers who had their schooling in state systems including in England It is clear that more is needed than merely literacy Global communications technologies mean that the way young people organize for either peace or terrorism lies mostly outside the school But this does not mean that schools are without power Lynn Davies proposes a very different educational strategy to the conventional tolerant multiculturalism that pertains in the west The task a challenging one is to politicize young people without cementing uncritical acceptance of single truths The chapters cover the nature of extremism and myth making identity and belonging religious belief and faith schools justice and revenge free speech humor and satire and critical thinking and critical respect In proposing an education which allows for alternatives and ambiguity the book argues for the centrality of political education media education and active citizenship education as well as critical and comparative religious education all firmly based on a universal value position around human rights A strong civil society is one that is not afraid to critique but which has people with the skills and dispositions to engage in this without violence Waterstone's Guide to Books Waterstone &
