Rom,1962 A thrust program called perigee propulsion which minimizes gravity loss is analyzed Thrust is applied intermittently in regions of high velocity near successive perigees The increased energy addition efficiency yields mass ratios approaching those for impulsive velocity change Corresponding times to reach desired energy are in days but are still small relative to mission times For specified
