

Roman Catholic Funeral Service Program: Honouring Faith and Remembering Loved Ones



In Singapore, Roman Catholic funeral services are deeply rooted in tradition and faith, providing solace and support to grieving families during their time of loss. These services, conducted with reverence and respect, honour the departed and offer comfort to those left behind.

Central to the Roman Catholic funeral service is the belief in the resurrection of the body and the soul's journey to eternal life with God. As such, these services are marked by rituals and prayers that reflect this belief, guiding both the departed and the mourners through the process of grieving and acceptance.

The Catholic funeral service typically begins with a Vigil, also known as the Wake, where family and friends gather to pay their respects to the deceased. This is often held at the funeral home or the family's residence, providing an opportunity for loved ones to share memories and offer condolences. During the Vigil, prayers such as the Rosary may be recited, along with readings from Scripture and hymns sung in remembrance of the departed.
