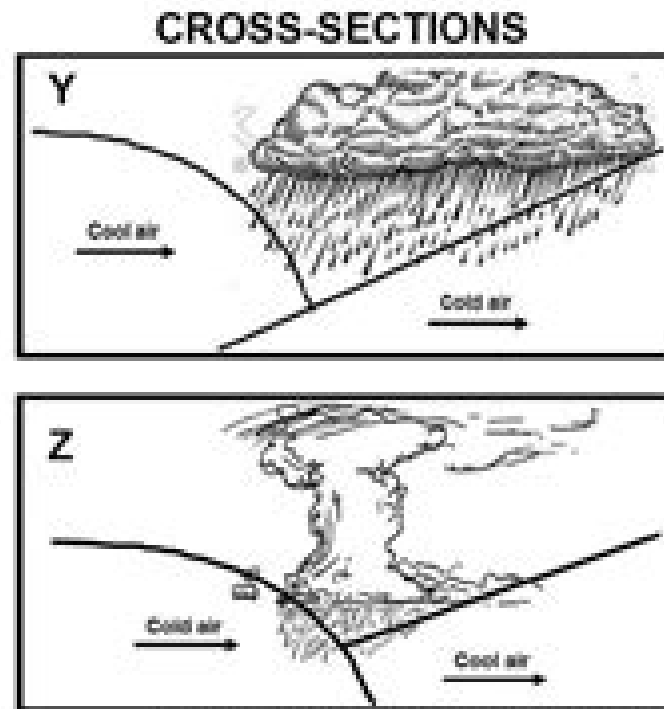

Evaluating the Local Impacts of the Rio Olympics Marcelo Neri, 2020-07-05 This book evaluates the local impacts and legacies of the Olympics in Rio by comparing Rio 2016 with other Olympic experiences and evaluating the ways in which the Games served the city. The 2016 Rio Olympic Games took place in a scenario of enormous economic challenges and persistent inequalities.
