# ORIGINS OF THE MUTAPA STATE.

The arguments of Beach hold much water in refinting the credibility of the salt expedition theory. Nevertheless one wishes to highlight that those arguments of Beach are dressed with weaknesses, freecosts, and far first-hed.
