The patient is a 45-year-old female who presents with chronic low back pain (LBP) and right leg pain. She reports an acute exacerbation of her LBP and right leg pain that started 2 weeks ago.

OBJECTIVE PHRASE Examples

Postural Assessment & Symptom Location

- Patient stands with relatively depressed scapula and excessive scapular internal rotation on the right side.
- Cervical spine/shoulder complex rotated with unilateral shoulder flexion.
- Patient is unable to palpation along right supraspinatus tendon with active resistance.
- Unilateral hyperlordosis of thoracic spine present with forward head posture.
- Patient stands with legs shifted to avoid full weight bearing on left side.
- Excessive knee hyperextension present with standing.
- Right ankle observed to exhibit foot collapse with performance of partial squat.

Vital Signs

- Resting BP measured in sitting in right arm: 120/80
- Resting HR: 72 bpm
- Respiratory Rate: 18

Joint ROM

- Neck Flexion: 50° / 60° / 70°
- Neck Extension: 10° / 0° / -10°

Gait & Functional Movement Tests

- Patient ambulates with an antalgic gait pattern, favoring right leg.
- Post this observation noted as right at normal gait.

- Excessive hip relative flexion present during left swing phase.
- Poor posterior translation observed with performance of sit to stand.
- Forward abduction and medial rotation observed with repeating.
- Forward progression noted with performance of single leg stance.

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ASSESSMENT EXAMPLES

Sample Assessment Formula

The patient (action word) (identify location of problem) (task or movement) with (observable impairments or performance). During this (action instruction) resulted (outcome).

Ex: The patient demonstrated poor performance of partial squat (task or movement) with excessive anterior displacement of femur. Instructions to feet stable were successful in decreasing pain while using these (performance).

The patient demonstrated lack of core muscle recruitment during a posterior, braced position in an extension of spine to improve movement in order to achieve greater knee extension.

Action words:

- Demonstrated, performed, lifted, reached, pulled, carried, bent.

Quality of Performance

- Proper, improved, unimpaired, controlled, poor, unstable, coordinated, hesitant.

Task or Movement

- Partial squat, walking, stepping up, reaching, lifting, carrying, into flexion, with abduction, etc.

Specific Impairments or Improvements

- Excessive femoral anterior displacement, poor recruitment of glute, lack of push off in last improved recruitment of glute, etc.

skilled Instruction

- Engage the lower abdominal, increase glute upon step up, relaxing the upper trapezius with reaching, etc.

Outcome

- Resulted in decreased pain, improved ROM, better position of the joint during motion, less shuffling/stepping, better ability to sit, lie overhead, etc.
