1. **Define an objective effect and a subjective effect (lecture)**
 - objective effect: those that can be directly observed by others; publically observable and measureable events**
 - subjective effect: those that cannot be directly observed by others; private event within a person**
 - emotions**
2. **What does consciousness refer to? (133)**
 - one's moment by moment subjective experience**
 - one's subjective experience of the world, resulting from brain activity**
3. **What does consciousness "clearly involve?" (lecture)**
 - clearly involves brain activity**
 - clearly involves attention and awareness**
4. **What does attention "roughly equate to" on the topic of consciousness? (lecture)**
 - attention roughly equates to conscious awareness**
 - we consciously direct our attention**
 - ex. Messy desk, looking for scissors at your desk, start by looking in places where you think they should be**
5. **What two types of processing affect conscious awareness? (134; lecture)**
 - automatic: routine tasks; so well learned that we do them without much attention**
 - ex. tying shoelace, brushing your teeth**
 - controlled: slower than automatic processing, but it helps people perform in complex or novel situations**
 - ex. attending college lecture, learning a new musical instrument**
 - what can effect consciousness: drugs, traumatic event, sleep deprivation**
6. **Describe the "cocktail party phenomenon?" (134)**
 - you can focus on a single conversation in the midst of a chaotic cocktail party, however, a particularly pertinent stimulus—such as hearing your name mentioned in another conversation or hearing a juicy piece of gossip—can capture your attention**
 - cocktail party phenomenon: ability to block out stimuli in a chaotic environment**
 - ability to block irrelevant stimuli**
7. **What is sensory gating? (lecture)**
 - neurological processes of filtering out redundant or unnecessary stimuli in the brain from all possible environmental stimuli**
8. **What is inattentional blindness? (lecture)**
 - people fail to perceive an object or event that is visible, but not attended to**
 - missing something in plain sight**
 - brain probably processed it, but excluded from being relevant**
