Purity and Monotheism Walter Houston,1993-01-01 The distinction between clean and unclean animals probably originating in tensions between shepherds and farmers is in the biblical laws of Leviticus 11 and Deuteronomy 14 transformed into an important theological principle In this wide ranging and elegantly written study Houston argues that the avoidance of unclean foods is a mark of the exclusive devotion of Israel to one god In a concluding chapter it is suggested that the abolition of the distinction in early Christianity corresponds to the universal horizon of the new faith **Leviticus** Johnson M. Kimuhu,2008 Whereas many books in this field deal with individual aspects or texts of the study of family laws Leviticus The Priestly Laws and Prohibitions from the Perspective of Ancient Near East and Africa examines extensively biblical texts ancient Near Eastern text and oral traditions from Africa Thus three different cultures converge the world of the Hebrew Bible the world of the ancient Near East and the world of Africa This volume examines in detail the history of the development of ancient laws in general and family laws in particular especially the laws relating to marriages between close relatives Furthermore Johnson M Kimuhu looks at prohibitions and taboos in Africa and the problems they pose with regard to the interpretation and translation of difficult biblical concepts into African languages In that sense Kimuhu provides an example of how to contextualize or integrate African traditions into the study of biblical Hebrew and he also offers insights into the current debate on the study of kinship from the point of view of social cultural anthropology and the Hebrew Bible legal system Teachers students and researchers in biblical studies ancient Near Eastern studies African traditions and social cultural anthropology will find this book helpful in their quest to understand family laws prohibitions and taboos

Glimpses of a Strange Land Cyril S. Ayodeji Adewuya, 2011-02-01 This book examines 2 Cor 6 14 7 1 and argues that its theological message is communal holiness It culminates in an attempt to posit a Pauline theology of corporate sanctification in the Corinthian correspondence Paul's view of sanctification it is argued should be seen as multifaceted relational communal ethical and mission oriented Thus a coherent picture of Pauline teaching on holiness in the Corinthian

correspondence emerges from this book For Paul the focus of God's redemptive activity is primarily the community and not the individual Paul's view on holiness has to do with communal holiness within the people of God the goal of which is to make God known to the wider society In sum this book argues that the teaching on holiness should not be and cannot be satisfactorily explained in terms of the individual but only as the individual stands in relation to the community of faith Thus the conclusion offers a corrective to some strands of modern interpretation that emphasize the individualistic experiential aspects of Christian holiness thus tending to reduce Christian holiness to morality
