1.1 — Introducing Psychology

- **psychology** = the study of the behavior and the mind
 - **behavior** = natural processes subject to nature as observable actions
 - **mind** = sensations, perceptions, cognitions, emotions, etc., not readily observed

Historical Philosophical/Physiological Perspectives

- **Socrates** and his student **Plato** believed humans contain **innate** knowledge that cannot be obtained by observing the world
- On the other hand, **Aristotle** believed we derived (observe) knowledge from the physical world
- **dualism** = belief that the world is divided into 2 parts **body and spirit** = (body vs mind)
 - supported by **Rene Descartes**
- **empiricism** = belief that acquisition of truth through **observation and experience**
 - supported by **John Locke**
 - proposed the term **tabula rasa** (blank slate = mind as a blank)
 - we are all born with **tabula rasa** and must learn everything from there
- **materialism** = belief that the only things that exist are **matter and energy**
 - supported by **Thomas Hobbes**, also supported **behaviorism**
- **Carlsson** = behaviorist experiments and scientific method
 - father of modern science

- **Mary Whiton Calkins** = first female psychology graduate and first female APA president
- **Leta McGee Swinburn** = first woman to receive PhD in psychology
- **Charles Darwin** = evolutionary perspective and natural selection
- **Karl Marx** = major advocate for rights of mentally ill
- **Sigmund Freud** = father of psychoanalysis
- **G. Stanley Hall** = first president of APA
- **William James** = father of functionalism
- **Ivan Pavlov** = classical conditioning
- **Jean Piaget** = developmental stages and emphasizing peer interaction in children
- **Carl Rogers** = father of humanistic view
- **B.F. Skinner** = operant conditioning
- **John B. Watson** = father of behaviorism
- **William Murrell** = father of psychology and influence on structuralist view
