

 - Observational study real world generalizations, but lack of control and time/money required.
 - Case study info depth, but difficult to generalize
 - experimental research manipulate variable and make causal inferences.
 - Covariation As X changes, Y changes
 - Temporal order Change in X occurs before change in Y
 - Absence of alternative explanations presence of other factors that might have causes that caused change in Y are ruled out
