Classified into the following: formable steels, high strength formable steels, weathering structural steels, structural steels, hardenable steels. They have excellent forming properties, electromagnetic properties, paintability, weldability, and are suitable for fabrication by forming, pressing and bending. Applications include domestic applications, automotive applications, lighting fixtures, electrical components (stators, rotors) and various kinds of sections roofing applications, profiled sheets, wall elements, etc. Typical thickness between 0.3 - 3 mm. Hot-Dip Galvanized Steel	Obtained by passing cold rolled coil through a molten zinc bath, in order to coat the steel with a thin layer of zinc to provide corrosion resistance; can be further processed.
