Kidd was awed by the bees' vibrating hum and mystery; it led to her researching the life of bees. She discovered the importance of the queen, the role of the worker bees, the "moods" of bees, and some of the idiosyncracies they displayed.

Bees have a lore and legend about them; they are symbols of the soul, of death, or rebirth. Even the Virgin Mary has been represented and thought of as a "Queen Bee"; in this book, Kidd sees her as a queen bee of a hive of women in a pink house.
