Spying Through a Glass Darkly Cécile Fabre, 2022 Cécile Fabre draws back the curtain on the ethics of espionage and counterintelligence Espionage and counter intelligence activities both real and imagined weave a complex and alluring story Yet there is hardly any serious philosophical work on the subject Cécile Fabre presents a systematic account of the ethics of espionage and counterintelligence She argues that such operations in the context of war and foreign policy are morally justified as a means but only as a means to protect oneself and third parties from ongoing violations of fundamental rights In doing so she addresses a range of ethical questions are intelligence officers morally permitted to bribe deceive blackmail and manipulate as a way to uncover state secrets Is cyberespionage morally permissible Are governments morally permitted to resort to the mass surveillance of their and foreign populations as a means to unearth possible threats against national security Can treason ever be morally permissible Can it ever be legitimate to resort to economic espionage in the name of national security The book offers answers to those questions through a blend of philosophical arguments and historical examples
