England in 1621 and came to America about 1634 Entries typically include the descendant's full name date and place of birth name of spouse and date of marriage names of spouse's parents date of death and place of burial and names of children with date and place of birth for each Additional information such as occupation is often provided A list of sources and a full name index add to the value of this work
