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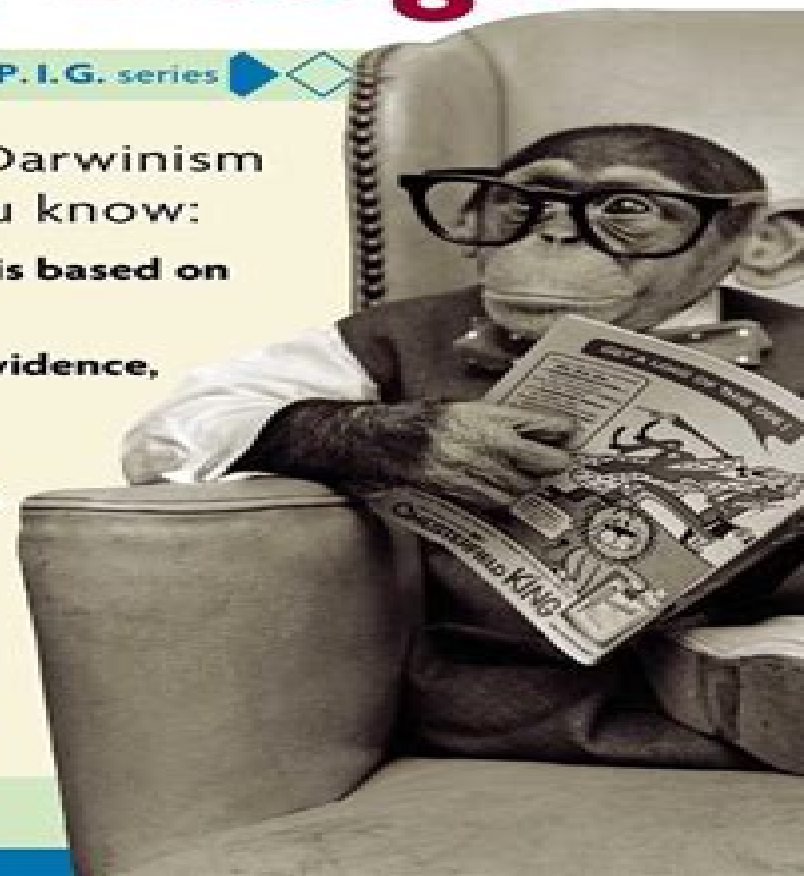

evolution Throughout the book Bethell makes questionable claims about subjects as varied as AIDS careful U S studies had already shown that at least a thousand sexual contacts are needed to achieve heterosexual transmission of the virus and extinction It is not possible definitely to attribute any given extinction to human activity and backs up his arguments with references to the music magazine SPIN and thriller writer Michael Crichton Ironically Bethell ends up proving his own premise by producing a highly politicized account of how liberal intellectuals and unchecked government agencies have created a white coated priesthood whose lust for grant money has driven them to produce fearsome but in Bethell s view false tales of ozone destruction and AIDS pandemics In the end this book is unlikely to sway readers who aren t already in Bethell s ideological camp as any points worthy of discussion get lost in the glut of unsourced claims that populate this latest installment of The Politically Incorrect Guide series
