Meninges of SC

Three fibrous membranes enclose SC and brain

- Superficial deep.
 - Dura mater tough sheath composed of multiple layers of deese connective tissue
 - Epidural space space between vertebral canal and dura mater
 - Contains blood vessels, adipose and loose connective tissue
 - Anachnoid mater arachnoid membrane connecting dura mater to pia mater
 - Subarachmoid space filled with cerebrospinal fluid (CSF)
 - Pia mater delocate, transparent membrane closely adhered to the spinal cond/brain. Fuses with dura mater to correct to caudal vertebrae

Cross Sectional Anatomy

Gray marker - somes, dendrines, proximal parts of the axons, gray because little envelop-

- Dorsal horn receives sensory nerve fibers, synapsing with interneurons
- Westral horn scenas of motor neurons that send axons out spinal nerves.
- Lateral horn in thoracolumbar segments sympathetic neurons leave SC hors

White matter - bundles of axons called "tracts" in SC that transmit signals along the information superhighway

Dorsal; lateral and ventral "columns" – divided into tracts

Central column - potential space in adults, CSF in young

Ascending Tracts

- Sensory signals traveling "up" the SC
- Those neuron puthway
 - First under detects stimulus in body and transmits up SC to brainstem.
 - Second-order takes message from brainstem to thalamso (port of the brain).
 - Third-order takes the message to the part of the brain involved.

Descending Tracts

- Motor signals traveling "down" the SC
- No descending tracts in the dorsal column
- Two neuron pathway
