Praying The Psalms As Poems One:

As It Was Written Justin Taylor, 2007-06-08 *As It Was Written* is a first book about the Bible that presupposes no previous knowledge. In seventeen chapters eleven for the Old Testament and six for the New Testament every book of the Bible is discussed. The origins and message of each book are told against the background of the history of Israel and of the Church. The main focus is on the Bible's meaning for the Catholic Christian reader today. A final two chapters discuss the Bible as God's book, inspiration, the truth of the Bible and the Church's book, the canon, Scripture and tradition, the magisterium, the Bible in the life of the church. Each chapter includes study questions for individual reflection or for group discussion. A list of suggested titles is also offered for further reading. Author Justin Taylor believes that there is a hunger among Catholics for the Word of God. They want to read, study and pray the Scriptures by themselves or with others. *As It Was Written* is for all those who want such guidance in understanding the Bible, its history, its background and above all its message.

Introduction to Psalms Hermann Gunkel, 2020-02-05 Hermann Gunkel's commentary on Psalms, *Die Psalmen HKAT*, considered by many to be his magnum opus, was published in 1926. But he was unable to complete his final work on the Psalms. The severe suffering of the final months of his life forced him to hand over his incomplete manuscript at Christmastime 1931 to his pupil Joachim Begrich. Gunkel died on 11 March 1932. Begrich put the final touches on the organization of Gunkel's last work on Psalms and it was published in 1933 as *Einleitung in die Psalmen, die Gattungen der religiösen Lyrik Israels*. As with much of Gunkel's other work, the influence of *Einleitung in die Psalmen* on the study of the Psalms, Hebrew poetry and indeed the whole realm of Old Testament literature, lyric and cult, as already noted, can scarcely be overestimated.

Poetry and Prayer Francesca Bugliani Knox, John Took, 2016-03-03 Interdisciplinary and ecumenical in scope, *Poetry and Prayer* offers theoretical discussion on the profound connection between poetic inspiration and prayer, as well as reflection on the work of individual writers and the traditions within which they stand. Part I addresses the relationship of prayer and poetry. H. Auden and R. S. Thomas.

Qumran Prayer and Religious Poetry Nitzan, 2018-11-26 *Qumran Prayer and Religious Poetry* represents the first attempt to undertake a systematic comprehensive study of the liturgical and poetic texts which were discovered among the Dead Sea Scrolls from Qumran.
