Kathmandu: Practicing witchcraft is an evil act punishable by the law of the land. **However** it is widely practiced in rural parts of the country due to superstition, illiteracy, lack of public awareness, poverty and social and economic disparity. Most of the victims of witchcraft are women from humble socio-economic background, single women, differently-abled women, who are subjected to ill-treatment and torture on charges of practicing witchcraft.

law has defined that accusation of witchcraft is a heinous form of violence, such incidents still take place because of unequal power relations between men and women, who are deprived on property rights and access to law.

According to the statistics provided by the Nepal Police, it registered a total of 61 cases of witchcraft accusation and subsequent torture across the country in the fiscal 2020-21, which is an increase by 79.41 per cent compared to 34 cases of witchcraft accusation in the fiscal 2019-20. Police said 80 perpetrators of witchcraft charge-related violence were recorded in this period.
