#### PEDIATRIC HEAD TO TOE ASSESSMENT

#### THE INFANT (FROM 1 TO 12 MONTHS OF AGE)

PHYSICAL GROWTH

- 1. Weight: most rapid physical growth in infancy; the best measure of growth
  - a. Weight gain of 1 to 1% lbs/month during the first 6 months, doubling of birth weight at 6 months
  - b. Weight gain of 1/2 to 1/2 lb/month from 7 to 12 month, tripling of birth weight at 1 year
- Length: increase by 50% by 1 year.
- 3. Head Circumference
  - a. At birth, the head circumference (HC = 33 to 35 cm) is greater than the chest circumference (CC = 31 to 33)
  - b. HC grows at a rate of 0.5 to 1 inch per month
    - HC equals CC at 1 year.
  - c. HC increase of greater than 1 inch per month is a danger sign of hydrocephalus
- 4. Fontanels
  - a. Posterior fontanel (smaller triangular-shaped, also termed lambda) closes at 2 to 3 months
  - Anterior fontanel (bigger, diamond-shaped, also termed bregma) closes at 12 to 18 months. (Usually close at 18 months)
- Vision
  - a. Newborns see only gross patterns of light or bright colors
  - b. At 3 months: can follow moving objects 180 degrees
  - c. At 4 months: infant can recognize his/her mother and familiar objects
  - d. At 6 months: infant can perceive colors
  - After 9 months: infant can recognize facial characteristics and often smiles in response to the sight of a familiar face
  - AT 12 months: Depth perception has developed and infant may recognize where a change in level occurs (e.g. at the edge of the bed)
- Teething
  - a. At 6 to 7 months: the lower central incisors the first deciduous teeth or temporary or milk teeth erupts
  - At 12 months: complete incisors and 2 lower lateral incisors)

#### PSYCHOSOCIAL SKILLS

- 1 month: smiles indiscriminately
- 2 months: smiles socially
- 3 months: shows interest in the environment.
- 4 months: recognizes mother, the most significant person to him/her engages in social interactions/demands attention/shows excitement
- 5 to 6 months: recognizes parents, enjoys plays
- 7 to 8 months: fears strangers and cries in their presence (peak at 8 months)
- 9 to 10 months: shows beginning separation anxiety
- 10 to 12 months: shows emotions, begins to explore environment

#### SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT MILESTONE IN INFANCY

#### 1 month

- Head lags.
- Lift head for short periods, intermittently when prone
- Early crawling movements
- Follows moving objects to midline of vision
- Smiles indiscriminately

#### 2 months

- Posterior fontanel closes.
- Rolls from side to back
- Social smile appears
- Holds rattle briefly
- . Begins to follow moving objects to sides
- · Head lags when pulled to a sitting position

#### 3 months

Holds head erect and steady when held on sitting position
