Stevens, 1986-10-16 This book examines the relation of words and music in England and France during the three centuries following the Norman Conquest The basic material of the study includes the chansons of the troubadours and trouvères and the varied Latin songs of the period In addition to these lyric forms the author discusses the relations of music and poetry in dance song in narrative and in the ecclesiastical drama Professor Stevens examines the ready made often unconscious and misleading assumptions we bring to the study and performance of early music In particular he affirms the importance of Number in more than one sense as a clue to the aesthetic of the greater part of repertoire to the relation of words and melody and to the baffling problem of their rhythmic interpretation This is the first wide ranging study of words and music in this period in any language It will be essential reading for scholars of the music and the literature of medieval Europe and will provide a basic and comprehensive introduction to the repertoire for students

The Intimate Screen Jason Jacobs, 2000 This book explores the formative period of British television drama concentrating on the years 1936-55 It examines the continuities and changes of early television drama and the impact this had upon the subsequent golden age In particular it questions the caricature of early television drama as photographed stage plays and argues that early television pioneers in fact produced a diverse range of innovative drama productions using a wide range of techniques It also explores the often competing definitions about the form and aesthetics of early television drama both inside and outside the BBC Given the absence of an audio visual record of early television drama the book uses written archive material in order to reconstruct how early television drama looked and how it was considered by producers and critics whilst also offering a critical examination of surviving dramas such as Rudolph Cartier's *Nineteen Eighty Four* **The**

Drama of Ideas Martin Puchner, 2010-04-14 Most philosophy has rejected the theater denouncing it as a place of illusion or moral decay the theater in turn has rejected philosophy insisting that drama deals in actions not ideas Challenging both views *The Drama of Ideas* shows that theater and philosophy have been crucially intertwined from the start Plato is the presiding genius of this alternative history *The Drama of Ideas* presents Plato not only as a theorist of drama but also as a dramatist himself one who developed a dialogue based dramaturgy that differs markedly from the standard Aristotelian view of theater Puchner discovers scores of dramatic adaptations of Platonic dialogues the most immediate proof of Plato's hitherto unrecognized influence on theater history Drawing on these adaptations Puchner shows that Plato was central to modern drama as well with figures such as Wilde Shaw Pirandello Brecht and Stoppard using Plato to create a new drama of ideas Puchner then considers complementary developments in philosophy offering a theatrical history of philosophy that includes Kierkegaard Nietzsche Burke Sartre Camus and Deleuze These philosophers proceed with constant reference to theater using theatrical terms concepts and even dramatic techniques in their writings *The Drama of Ideas* mobilizes this

double history of philosophical theater and theatrical philosophy to subject current habits of thought to critical scrutiny In dialogue with contemporary thinkers such as Martha Nussbaum Iris Murdoch and Alain Badiou Puchner formulates the contours of a dramatic Platonism This new Platonism does not seek to return to an idealist theory of forms but it does point beyond the reigning philosophies of the body of materialism and of cultural relativism **Contemporary British Drama**
