Efficacy Of Counseling Intervention For Reducing Psycho - Social Issues With Special Reference To Teenagers Dr. K. Radha,2025-07-16

During adolescence teenagers often encounter various psycho social issues that can significantly impact their overall well being One prominent issue is identity formation and self esteem Teenagers go through a period of self discovery and self definition which can lead to confusion self doubt and a search for their place in the world They may struggle with self acceptance body image concerns and a desire for validation from peers and society The present study aims to investigate the efficacy of counseling intervention in reducing psycho social issues among teenagers Adolescence is a critical period characterized by significant physical emotional and social changes often accompanied by various challenges and concerns Psycho social issues such as stress anxiety depression self esteem problems interpersonal conflicts and behavioral issues can

significantly impact the overall well being and development of teenagers To know the need of counseling for dealing psycho social problems of teenagers is one of the main aims of this study Forty secondary schools will be selected as a representative sample from a pool of 285 20 of the 40 institutions included in the research provide counselling services and remaining not So our sample size will become 400 students and 400 teachers i e 10 each from 40 schools It is hypothesized that the counseling intervention will lead to a significant reduction in psycho social issues among teenagers in the intervention group compared to the control group The findings of this study are expected to provide empirical evidence regarding the effectiveness of counseling interventions in mitigating psycho social issues among teenagers The results obtained from this study will contribute to the existing literature on counseling interventions for teenagers and inform the development of targeted interventions aimed at improving the psycho social well being of adolescents This research has the potential to provide valuable insights for mental health professionals educators and policymakers to develop and implement effective strategies to address the psycho social challenges faced by teenagers ultimately promoting their overall well being and healthy development
