without Poets Boris Kayachev, 2021-03-31 The canon of classical Greek and Latin poetry is built around big names with Homer and Virgil at the center but many ancient poems survive without a firm ascription to a known author This negative category anonymity ties together texts as different as for instance the orally derived Homeric Hymns and the learned interpolation that is the Helen episode in Aeneid 2 but they all have in common that they have been maltreated in various ways consciously or through neglect by generations of readers and scholars ancient as well as modern These accumulated layers of obliteration which can manifest for instance in textual distortions or aesthetic condemnation make it all but impossible to access anonymous poems in their pristine shape and context The essays collected in this volume attempt each in its own way to disentangle the bundles of historically accreted uncertainties and misconceptions that affect individual anonymous texts including pseudepigrapha ascribed to Homer Manetho Virgil and Tibullus literary and inscribed epigrams and unattributed fragments Poems without Poets will be of interest to students and scholars working on any anonymous ancient texts but also to readers seeking an introduction to classical poetry beyond the limits of the established canon

Voice and Versification in Translating Poems James W. Underhill, 2016-12-09 Great poets like Shelley and Goethe have made the claim that translating poems is impossible And yet poems are translated not only that but the metrical systems of English French Italian German Russian and Czech have been shaped by the translation of poems Our poetic traditions are inspired by translations of Homer Dante Goethe and Baudelaire How can we explain this paradox James W Underhill responds by offering an informed account of meter rhythm rhyme and versification But more than that the author stresses that what is important in the poem and what must be preserved in the translated poem is the voice that emerges in the versification Underhill's book draws on the author's translation experience from French Czech and German His comparative analysis of the versifications of French and English have enabled him to revise the key terms involved in translating the poetic voice and transposing the poem's versification The theories of versification from the Prague School of Linguistics the French and Swiss schools of versification and recent scholarship in metrics and rhythm in the UK and in the USA have been

integrated into this synthetic but rigorously coherent approach to translating poems The extensive glossary at the end of the book will prove useful for both students and teachers alike And the detailed case studies on translating poems by Baudelaire and Emily Dickinson allow the author to categorize and appraise the various poetic and aesthetic strategies and theories that are brought to bear in translating Baudelaire into English and Dickinson into French Published in English *Shakespeare's Poems and Sonnets* Harold Bloom, 2009 Provides insight into the poems sonnets of William Shakespeare along with a brief biography **Shakespeare's Sonnets** William Shakespeare, 1995 Features the sonnets of Shakespeare this is one of a series for A Level students which contains both complete poems and extracts from longer works There is a biographical and critical introduction a commentary and notes on the poems **The Cambridge History of English Literature, 1660-1780** John Richetti, 2005-01-06 The Cambridge History of English Literature 1660 1780 offers readers discussions of the entire range of literary expression from the Restoration to the end of the eighteenth century In essays by thirty distinguished scholars recent historical perspectives and new critical approaches and methods are brought to bear on the classic authors and texts of the period Forgotten or neglected authors and themes as well as new and emerging genres within the expanding marketplace for printed matter during the eighteenth century receive special attention and emphasis The volume's guiding purpose is to examine the social and historical circumstances within which literary production and imaginative writing take place in the period and to evaluate the enduring verbal complexity and cultural insights they articulate so powerfully **Isaac Vossius's De poematum cantu et viribus rhythmici, 1673** Peter Martens, 2022-10-25 Dr Peter Martens provides the first complete edited English translation of and commentary on Isaac Vossius's *De poematum cantu et viribus rhythmici* a late seventeenth century work of Continental musical humanism all the more interesting for being published in England and dedicated to royalist Henry Bennett Duke of Arlington This treatise plays an important but poorly understood role in the continued development of rhythmopoeia Vossius continues the arguments of figures such as Vincenzo Galilei and Marin Mersenne desiring to link linguistic rhythm music and the passions by proposing a practical if undemonstrated method for doing so based on ancient poetic feet This resuscitation of poetic feet in the service of affect is made explicit by Vossius but is undoubtedly more familiar to musicologists from Wolfgang Caspar Printz's 1696 *Phrynis Mitilenaëus* or Johann Mattheson's 1739 *Der vollkommene Capellmeister* Vossius or more correctly *De poematum cantu* was often cited during the century after its publication and no modern treatment of rhythmopoeia seems complete without a citation or short excerpt from this work There is little secondary literature that focuses on this treatise but what does exist links this work directly to John Dryden's composition of his 1687 and 1697 *St Cecilia odes* and their musical settings by Giovanni Battista Draghi and Jeremiah Clarke respectively In Dean Mace and H Neville Davies debate over the extent of Vossius's influence on these works can be found a rich picture of the contentious issues surrounding text setting and musical affect that so occupied a great many writers in late seventeenth century England A full translation and accompanying
