women in urban areas Black women forged interracial relationships within this organization and made it not without much conflict and struggle one of the most socially progressive organizations in the city When Black women could not integrate historically white institutions they created their own They established financial and educational institutions such as Pressley School of Beauty Culture which beautician Mattie Pressley DeWese opened in 1946 as a result of segregation in the beauty training industry This school served economic educational and community development purposes as well as created economic opportunities for Black women Historically and contemporarily Milwaukee has been and is still known as one of the most segregated cities in the nation Black women have always contested urban inequality by making space for themselves and others on the margins In so doing they have transformed both the urban landscape and urban history
