on students perceptions of the programme but teaching experience was found to have no effect The possible relationship between the independent variables of age and Mathematics specialisation and the dependent variable of students perception of the programme was indicated in too few items to warrant a definite conclusion Implications for the improvement of the programme are that there is need for the college to revisit some aspects of the structure and organisation of the programme There is also need for further research involving all primary teachers colleges
