 - b) Child obesity is a serious health risk and leads to a broad range of physical problems such as:
 - 1. High blood pressure
 - 2. Diabetes
 - 3. High cholesterol level
 - 4. Joint disease (Epstein)
- Psychologically.
 - a) Psychological and social effects may be even more devastating to the child than the medical hazards (Shore).
 - b) Children are being teased for being overweight by their friends and peers, which leads to:
 - Social isolation
 - Emotional withdrawal
 - 3. Depression
 - Inactivity
 - 5. More overeating & further weight gain (Epstein)
