The average atomic mass is the weighted average of all the isotopes of an element.

Example: A sample of cesium is 75% 133Cs, 20% 132Cs and 5% 134Cs. What is its average atomic mass?

Answer: .75 x 133 = 99.75

 $.20 \times 132 = 26.4$

 $.05 \times 134 = 6.7$

Total = 132.85 amu = average atomic mass
