 Washington, Feb. 19—A report by Human Rights Watch, a New York City-based group, charges that 64 nations are guilty of using torture. The report, which is the first of a series, lists the nations and describes the methods used to torture prisoners.

The report, titled "Torture in the Americas," lists 64 nations: Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Denmark, Ecuador, France, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, India, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Luxembourg, Mexico, Netherlands, Nicaragua, Norway, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Portugal, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, United Kingdom, United States, Uruguay, Venezuela, and West Germany.

The report also lists the methods used to torture prisoners, including beatings, electric shocks, and the use of noose. It also lists the names of the individuals who were tortured.
